**\*\*Claude Monet : sunshine and waterlilies** -- Kelley, True. [ WC ]  
{IL K-3, 759.4} -- Grosset & Dunlap, c2001., RL 3.7, 32p  
Written as a report by a fictitious student, this biography of Monet profiles his life and artworks. (8 copies)

**\*\*Gershwin's Rhapsody in blue** -- Celenza, Anna Harwell. [ WC BL HB SL LM\* ] {IL 3-6, -Fic-} -- Charlesbridge, 2006., RL 6, 32p  
In January of 1924, a twenty-six-year-old pianist, George Gershwin, finds himself slated to compose, in only five weeks, a concerto that defines "American music," and the result is his masterpiece, Rhapsody in Blue. (8 copies)

**Crayons and computers : computer art activities for kids ages 4 to 8** -- Sabbeth, Carol, 1957- [ SL ] {IL K-3, 372.5} -- Chicago Review Press, c1998., RL 5.9, 139p  
Provides instructions for a variety of art projects children ages four through eight can make using a computer with a color monitor, printer, and basic paint or drawing program in combination with crayons, markers, and other materials; and incorporates lessons on color and famous artists.

**Hot jazz special** -- Hannah, Jonny. [ MR BL PW NY HB BI BC ] {IL K-3, 781.65} -- Candlewick Press, 2005., RL 2.5, 40p  
Presents an introduction to jazz and some of the most important musicians in jazz history, through vibrant text and illustrations that provide a representation of the music.

**Kids' crazy art concoctions : 50 mysterious mixtures for art & craft fun** -- Hauser, Jill Frankel, 1950- {IL K-3, 745.5} -- Williamson Pub., c1995., RL 3.4, 156p  
Provides instructions for making a variety of artistic concoctions involving water color cakes, soap paint, crazy dough, pastes, papers, and earthworks.

**Kids make music! : clapping & tapping from Bach to rock** -- Hart, Avery. [ LT ] {IL K-3, 780} -- Williamson Pub., 1993., RL 5.3, 156p  
Presents a variety of activities based on music, including singing and dancing, improvisation, and making homemade instruments.

**Make your own musical instruments** -- D'Cruz, Anna-Marie. {IL 3-6, 784.192} -- PowerKids Press, 2009., RL 4.3, 24p  
Provides illustrated, step-by-step instructions to create eight simple musical instruments, which includes Spanish castanets, bongo drums, an Egyptian harp, and others.

**Little hands create! : art & activities for kids ages 3 to 6** -- Dall, Mary Doerfler. [ BL SL ] {IL K-3, 745.5} -- Williamson Books, c2004., RL 4.2, 118p  
Presents instructions for a variety of art and activities for children ages three to six using recycled and other easily obtained materials.

**Mr. Satie and the great art contest** -- DePaola, Tomie, 1934- [ BK BL SL ] {IL K-3, -E-} -- Puffin Books, 2007, c1991., RL 4.7, 32p  
Mr. Satie came to visit his niece and nephew and told them a story about a great art dispute in Paris between two famous painters.

**No one saw : ordinary things through the eyes of an artist** -- Raczka, Bob. [ WC BL SL ] {IL 3-6, 759.06} -- Millbrook Press, c2002., RL 5.3, 32p  
Simple rhyming text and reproductions of paintings show young readers how certain artists saw the world.

**Piano starts here : the young Art Tatum** -- Parker, Robert Andrew. [ BL\* WC KR\* BK SL\* PW HB BC ] {IL K-3, 786.2} -- Schwartz & Wade Books, c2008., RL 4.5, 34p  
Explores early twentieth-century jazz pianist and virtuoso Art Tatum's passion and talent for playing the instrument, and includes illustrations and biographical information.  
The story of the orchestra : listen while you learn about the instruments, the music and the composers who wrote the music! -- Levine, Robert T. [ BK BL SL ] {IL 3-6, 784.2} -- Black Dog & Leventhal, c2001., RL 6.7, 96p

**Orchestra Bob teaches children about classical music and its most influential composers;** includes a CD-ROM with recordings of popular classical music pieces.

Those amazing musical instruments! : your guide to the orchestra through sounds and stories -- Helsby, Genevieve. [ SL\* ] {IL 3-6, 784.19} -- Sourcebooks, c2007., RL 6.9, 176p

Contains facts and stories about the history and construction of the individual instruments that make up an orchestra, including strings, woodwinds, brass, percussion, and keyboards, with discussion of the voice, electronic instruments, and the conductor, and features musical examples on CD-ROM.

**When I grow up : a young person's guide to interesting & unusual occupations** -- Loy, Jessica. [ LM ] {IL 3-6, 331.702} -- H. Holt, 2008., RL 6.3, 37p

Provides descriptions of the jobs done by professionals in fourteen unusual occupations, including chocolatier, game designer, and entomologist.
