### Fixed Payment Plan Application

The Fixed Payment Plan is available to matriculated full-time undergraduate students who are not receiving any form of financial aid (including loans) or scholarship. The plan covers tuition, registration and services fees, room, and board.

Increases in fees, such as laboratory fees, academic support fees, and insurance fees, will be payable each registration, as incurred, at the then current rate.

This plan does not cover summer registration, winter session registration or part-time enrollment.

Charges for these enrollments will be based on the then-current tuition rates.

Refunds will be made in full for unused semesters and in accordance with the University refund policy for any semester in which a student is currently registered.

Students transferring between schools of the University that have different tuition rates and those students who change on-campus residence halls, room types, and/or meal plans, also resulting in different rates, will be subject to adjustments based on differences existing during the first semester covered under the agreement.

#### TERMS OF THE AGREEMENT

You may elect to fix tuition costs, fix room and board costs, or fix both. This application and lump sum check payment are due in the NYU Office of the Bursar before **August 3, 2009**.

Students with fixed room/board charges must still comply with all housing deadlines. Participation in this plan does not guarantee eligibility for specific room types, housing options, or meal plans.

The fixed payment room/board plan does not cover costs associated with early check-in or school breaks.

The tuition prepayment is computed on the basis of tuition and registration and services fees plus other school-wide fees that are in effect for the school of registration as established at the first semester of registration under the plan, multiplied by the number of semesters that are prepaid.

The room and board prepayment is computed on the basis of residence hall, room type, (traditional or apartment), and meal plan selected for the first semester under the plan multiplied by the number of semesters that are prepaid.

Entitlement under the plan will expire at the end of the consecutive number of semesters for which prepayment is made, starting with the first full-time semester of registration following the date of the agreement.

The charts on the reverse side will assist you in computing your prepayment.

- \* All freshmen are required to maintain a minimum meal plan during the license period regardless of hall placement.
- \* All residents assigned to traditional style residence halls (Brittany, Goddard, Hayden, Rubin, Weinstein Hall and 12th St.) are required to maintain a minimum of 10 meals per week or 175 flex meal plan.
- \* Meal plans cannot be canceled or changed, whether used or not, unless the License is canceled or terminated by NYU, or unless you submit the online request by September 19, 2009 for Fall Term, and by February 6, 2010 for Spring Term.
- \* If Housing cancels your meal plan, it will also cancel all meal plan charges for the period following the date the cancellation takes effect.
- \* No refunds will be made if you miss meals, fail to obtain a valid ID card, or do not use your meal plan.
