RENOVATIONS and UPGRADES

As part of a University-wide initiative to upgrade academic and student spaces, 33 general purpose classrooms received replacement equipment or new instructional technology this past Summer. Twenty four classrooms were significantly renovated and/or constructed. Additionally, classrooms within the Silver Center, Meyer Building, & Bobst Library received new computers, data/video projectors and equipment media racks.

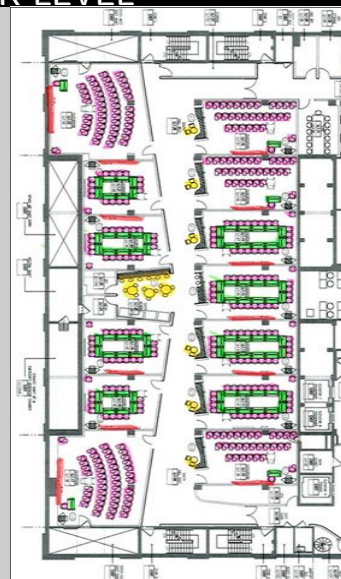
13 New General Purpose Classrooms in BOBST LOWER LEVEL

The construction in Bobst Library Lower Level One has added 13 general purpose classrooms - both lecture and seminar style classrooms.

The construction included renovation of the bathroom facilities on LL1 and LL2 and creation of several new graduate student research rooms in the Brine Library Commons.

Technology in the 11 small classrooms includes a Crestron media processor with wall mounted touch panel, document camera, DVD/VHS combo player, Dell computer with wireless keyboard and trackball, Da-Lite equipment enclosure with custom finish, data/video projector, two zone lighting control, electric projection screen and NYU-Roam wireless access.

Technology installed in each of the two (2) large classrooms includes two 4000 lumen data/video projectors, two electric projection screens, DVD/VHS player, Crestron media processor with wall mount touch panel, custom Da-Lite equipment enclosure, MAC Mini computer with wireless keyboard and trackball and wireless lavalier microphone.

NEW BOBST LIBRARY SATELLITE OFFICE

OTHER UPGRADES & ADDITIONS

24 Waverly Place, 45 West 4th-Goddard, Meyer Hall, & Silver Center General purpose classrooms received upgrades. The upgrades include new furniture, seating, painting, and technology upgrades which includes the Crestron media processor with wireless touch panel.

Two new classrooms were created in the Weinstein Sub-basement, (SB20 & SB35). The new classrooms feature a 55" LED monitor, DVD/VHS, laptop connection, Dell computer with wireless keyboard and track ball and NYU wireless access.

WIRELESS TOUCH PANELS

Many of our classrooms are equipped with the Crestron Wireless Touch panel. The touch panel is lectern-mounted and gives instructors convenient one-touch system control.

Customized programming allows instructors enjoy a simplified touch panel interface with complete room control. With a touch of the screen, icons are displayed for the PC, DVD/VHS player, laptop, document camera and lights. Instructors simply choose their desired mode of presentation and, with a press on the icon, lights automatically dim, the screen lowers and the projector powers on. When the session is over, another button press reverses the process, shutting the system down.
