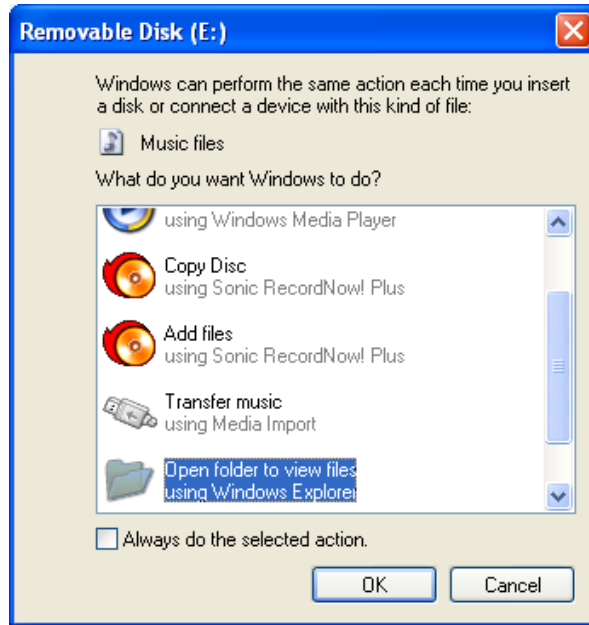


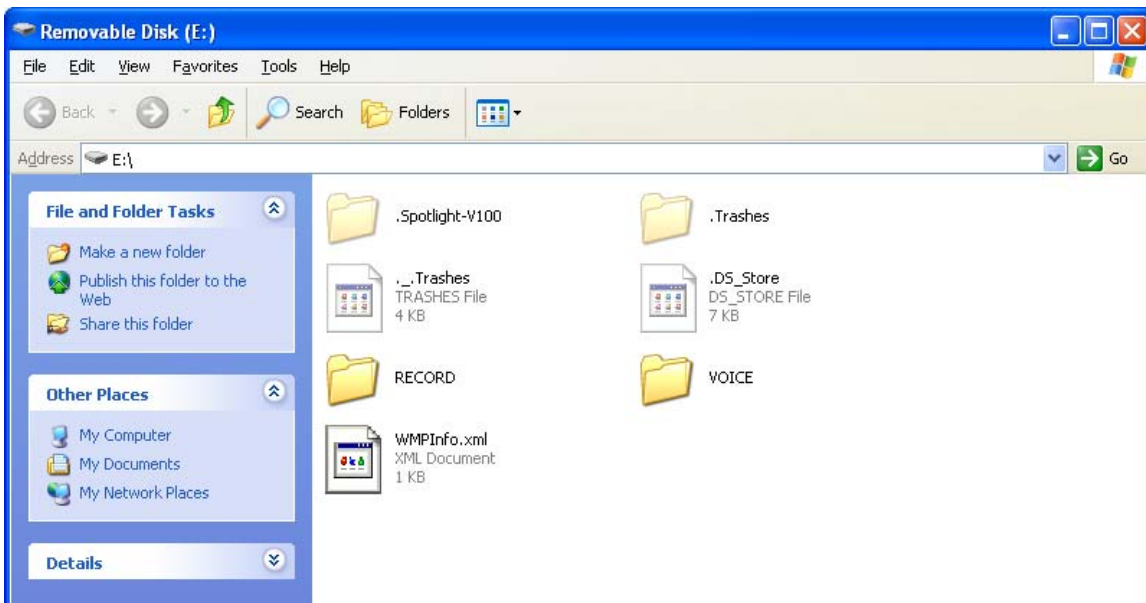
Copy voice recordings from iriver MP3 recorder to computer

Instructions April 2010

- **CONNECT** iriver MP3 recorder to computer using provided USB – mini-USB cable.
- The following **DIALOG BOX** should appear:



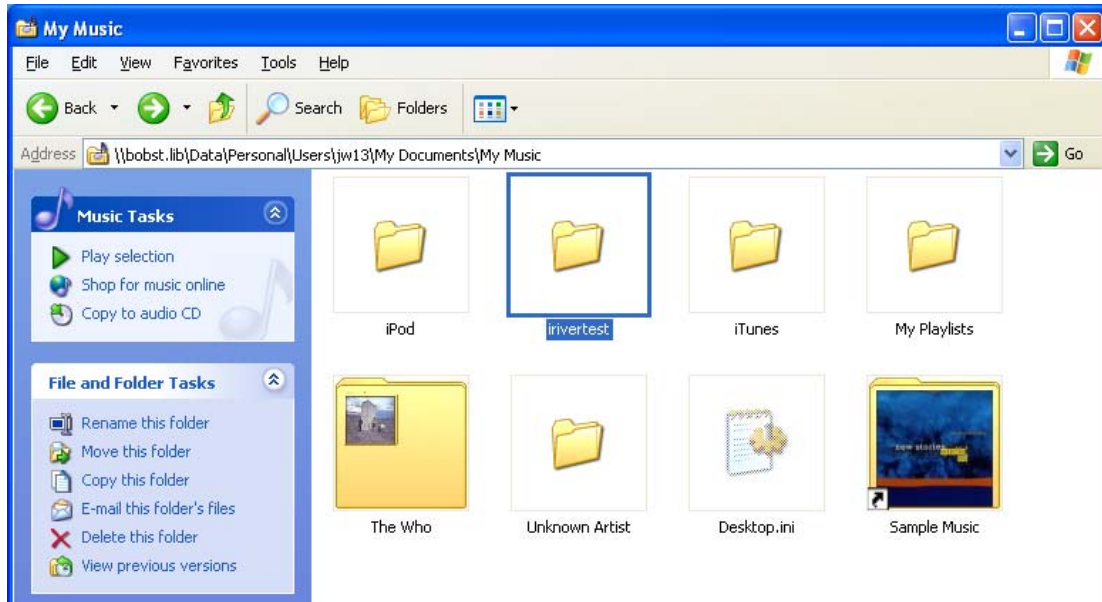
- If **REMOVABLE DISK** dialog box doesn't appear, double click the **MY COMPUTER** icon, then double-click the **REMOVABLE DISK** drive icon.
- Double-click **OPEN FOLDER TO VIEW FILES USING WINDOWS EXPLORER** or highlight and select **OK**. The following dialog box will appear:



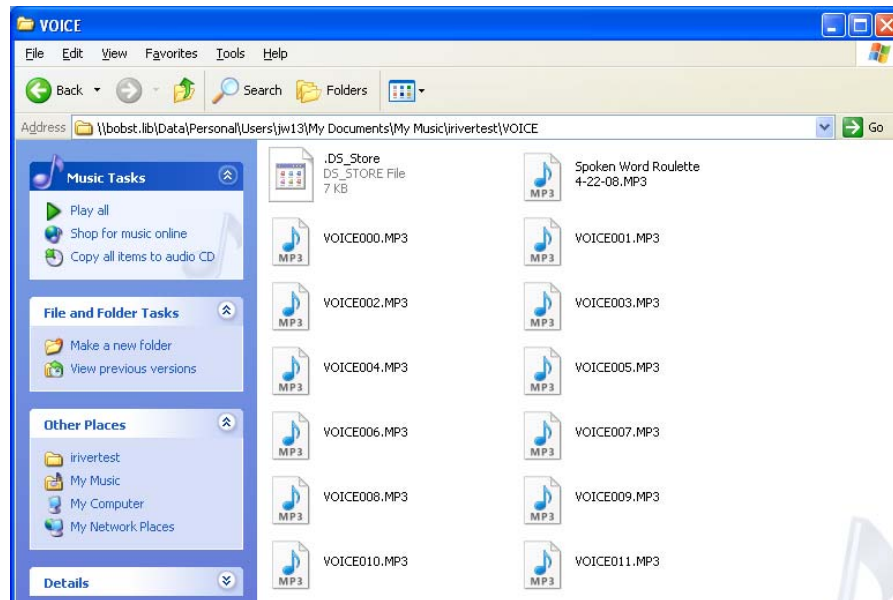
- Click and drag the **VOICE** folder to your desk top, **OR** create a folder in the **DOCUMENTS** folder. These instructions have created a folder in the **MY MUSIC** folder.
- Open **MY DOCUMENTS**, than open **MY MUSIC**. Create a new folder and name it. For these instructions, this folder is named **IRIVERTEST**.

- Click and drag the **VOICE** folder into the new folder (irivertest).
- Alternately, you can click and drag the **VOICE** folder into the **MY DOCUMENTS** folder without creating a separate new folder.
- Open **VOICE** folder to view the MP3 files.



- Double-click the file to playback and the default media player (typically Windows Media Player or itunes) will play recording.
- Once all files have been copied to the computer and confirmed, click the **SAFELY REMOVE HARDWARE ICON** (typically in the task bar on the bottom of the screen). Remove iriver MP3 recorder and cable.
