The Expository Writing Program at New York University invites applications for lecturer positions. These are full-time, non-tenure track, one-year appointments, subject to renewal. Lecturers teach six writing sections or their equivalent over the academic year and participate in faculty development activities. The Program requires three years teaching writing at a college or university, including one year as an instructor. A PhD is preferred.

We will begin reviewing applications on **February 27, 2009** for Fall 2009 appointments, subject to budgetary and administrative approval. Your application should include: cover letter; current CV; recent sample of your own writing (15-page max.); a student paper that represents advanced work; assignments for that paper; a student's responses to those assignments; and a reflective letter in which you assess the student's written performance.
