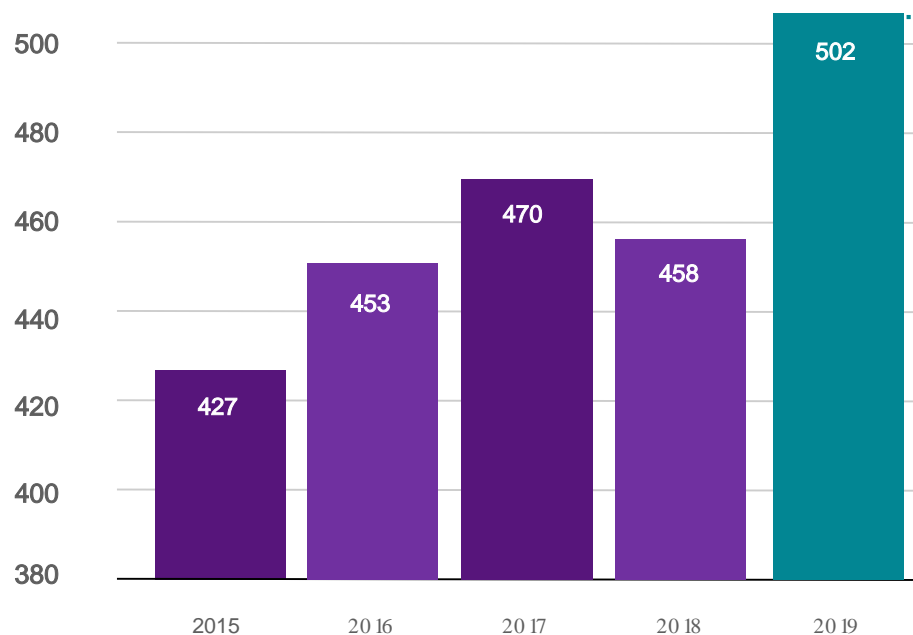

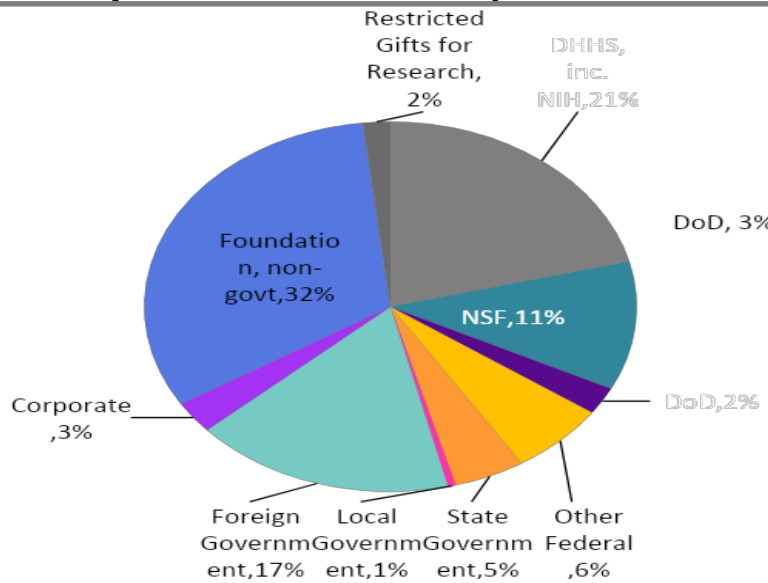




SPA has approximately 3,200 Active Projects in FY 2020

- Focused efforts in 2020+ to enhance OSP/SPA support of units
 - Coordination through regular portfolio management meetings
 - Risk Assessment and monitoring of subrecipients
 - Comprehensive stewardship beyond regulatory compliance-research integrity
- CAYUSE tools and additional integrations with FAME to better:
 - Define criteria for high risk awards and engage PIs and departments in project management reviews
 - Identify, translate and monitor key award compliance criteria and deliverables throughout award life cycle
- Refresh existing policies and expand “bench” of guidance
 - “Marry” OSP’s wiki with SPA’s handbook
- Co-develop and launch Research Administrator Academy
