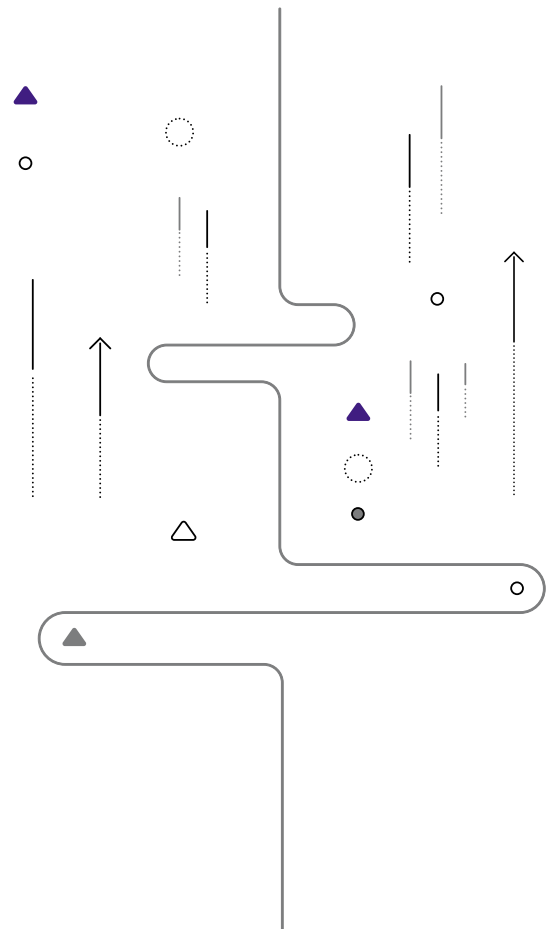

MAY 1 Housing Application

RESIDENTIAL LIFE AND HOUSING SERVICES

Freshmen who are interested in living on campus must complete the online application and submit the \$1000 housing reservation payment to guarantee placement for the 2017-2018 academic year.

Transfer students are not guaranteed housing and are encouraged to actively seek off-campus housing arrangements, however non-renewable (non-guaranteed) housing applications may be completed for possible consideration.

JULY 18 Fall Semester Bill is Available

AUGUST 1 Health Requirements Due

STUDENT HEALTH CENTER

Mandatory Immunization and health history forms are due. Alcohol and sexual misconduct online trainings must also be completed by this date. Failing to meet requirements can result in being dropped from classes.
