

## General Responsibilities of NYUCD Post Graduate Residents

All residents are expected to:

- 1) Provide safe, effective and compassionate patient care commensurate with his/her level of advancement and competence, as directed by and under the general supervision of appropriately privileged attending teaching staff.
- 2) Demonstrate appropriate levels of training and competence, participate in the educational activities of the Advanced Education Program, and as appropriate, assume responsibility for teaching and supervising other students, and participating in institutional orientation programs.
- 3) Participate in institutional committees and councils to which the resident is appointed or invited.
- 4) Develop an understanding of ethical, socio-economic and medical-legal issues that affect post-graduate dental education and application of cost-containment measures in the provision of patient care.
- 5) Perform all duties in accordance with the established practices, procedures, and policies of NYUCD and those of its programs, clinical departments, and other institutions to which the resident is assigned.
- 6) Be prepared for fulfill all assigned clinical and didactic scheduled assignments, including weekend emergency on call assignment where appropriate.
