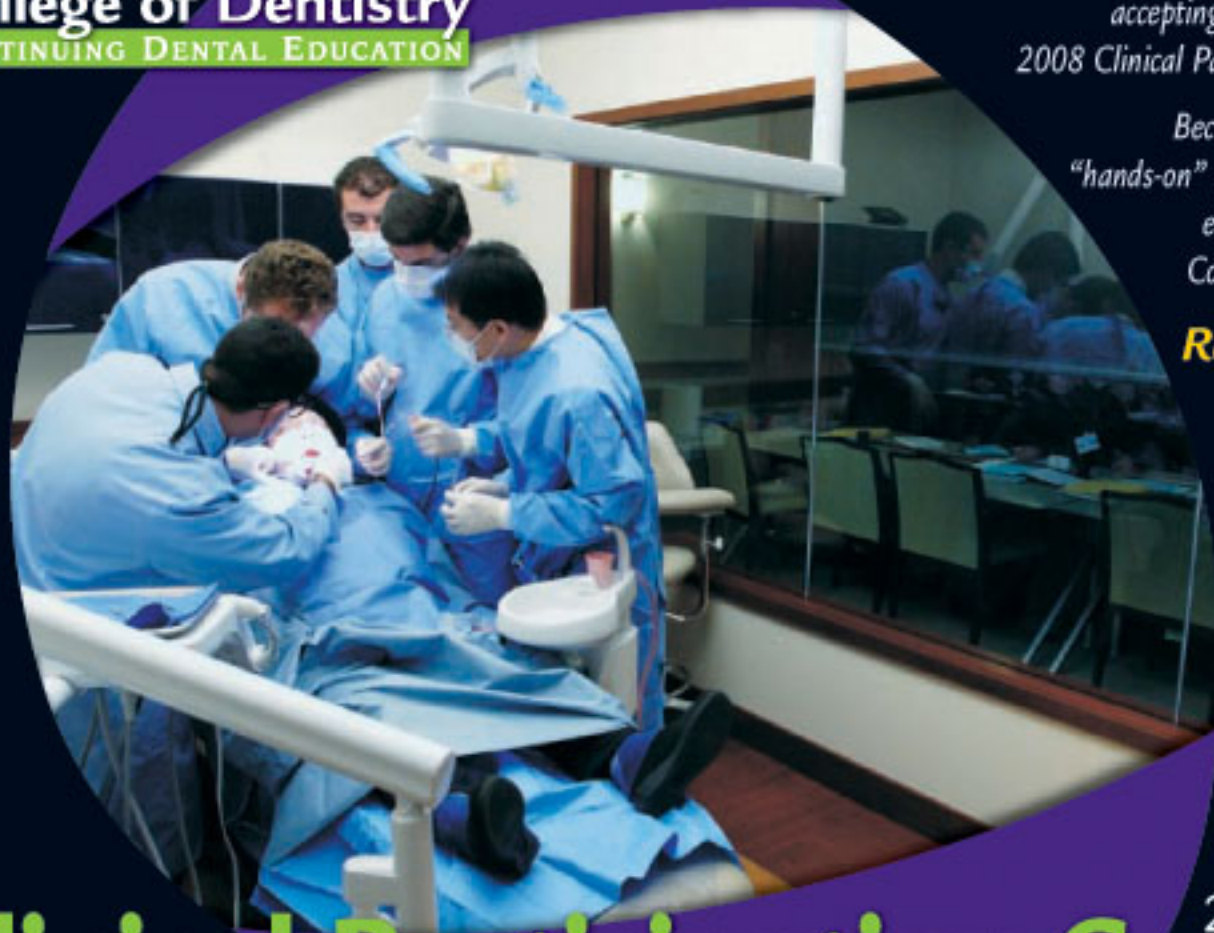

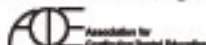

Comprehensive Aesthetic Dentistry: Principles and Practice

Clinical training will range from indirect (veneers, single crowns, onlays, inlays, crown and bridge) to direct restorations as well as the latest in bleaching techniques. At the conclusion of this course, participants will be able to formulate, present and execute a comprehensive aesthetic treatment plan in restorative dentistry.

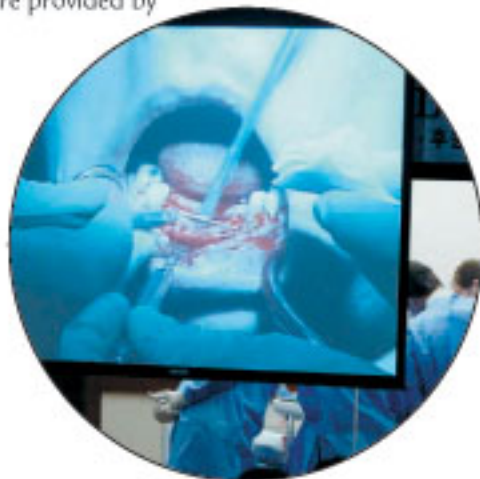
