Implantology: Surgical and Prosthetic Treatment

2-YEAR PROGRAM: September – June

Participants will be assigned to one of the following sessions offered on Mondays, Wednesdays or Thursdays

Credit Hours: Approximately 200 annually

Tuition: **\$13,700** annually (for registrants beginning fall 2011), Payment plan is available

Achieve new heights in your understanding and implementation of implant dentistry into your practice! Over the two-year program, you will work closely with dedicated faculty that are available to you every session. You will enhance your skills in extractions, guided bone and soft tissue regeneration and be able to place implants to support many types of fixture-assisted dental restorations that are common in practices today. You will see both screw-retained and cemented, fixed and removable restorations. You will learn how to photograph and properly document cases. In addition to clinical treatment you will attend group “study” sessions, where you will observe and present “case evaluations”, as well as be exposed to didactic lectures presented by seasoned clinicians who are on the cutting edge of implant surgery and restorations. You will have the opportunity to bring cases from your private office for review and discussion. The goal of this course is to provide you with a basic skill set in a unique setting, which will ultimately be a means of increasing production in your private office. Participants can expect to complete surgical and prosthetic treatment on patients, whom we will provide.

Advanced Aesthetics: “An Integrated Approach to Aesthetics & Function”

1-YEAR PROGRAM: September - June

TUESDAYS 8:00 AM - 3:30 PM

Credit Hours: Approximately 210

Tuition: **\$11,900** (for registrants beginning fall 2011), Payment plan is available

The goal of this course is to train dentists in a scientific and predictable approach to aesthetic dentistry. This didactic and clinical participation course emphasizes the disciplines of prosthodontics, occlusion, periodontics, orthodontics, and implantology, integrated into the art and science of dental aesthetics. Clinical training will range from indirect (veneers, single crowns, onlays, inlays, crown and bridge, implant restorations,) to direct restorations, tooth whitening, and the role of occlusion to create beautiful functional restorations. You will learn the skills necessary to build a successful aesthetic practice. At the conclusion of this course, participants will be able to formulate, present and execute a comprehensive aesthetic treatment plan in restorative dentistry, along with developing strong clinical skills in case documentation and photography, occlusion, prosthodontics, adhesive dentistry, tooth whitening techniques and practice management.

Full-Mouth Reconstruction: “Advanced Principles and Practice for the GP” Implants, Aesthetics and Occlusion

1-YEAR PROGRAM: September – June

FRIDAYS 8:00 AM – 3:30 PM

Credit Hours: Approximately 200

Tuition: **\$11,300** (for registrants beginning fall 2011), Payment plan is available

Learn to diagnose, treat and manage difficult conventional and implant supported full-mouth rehabilitation cases. Refine your clinical skills and theoretical knowledge in all facets of prosthodontics. Understand the rationale of articulation and occlusion driven diagnosis and treatment planning in fixed, removable, and implant prostheses. Learn provisional restoration, communication and photography as they set up any case for success. Restore different types of ceramic restorations with some of the leaders in dental technology. Using computer aided designs and CAD/CAM technologies we can create aesthetic long-term prosthetics with a sound occlusion. Advanced education on materials, TMJ, aesthetic and implant dentistry will also be demonstrated. Participants will work closely with teaching faculty and master dental technicians to enhance a team approach to full-mouth reconstruction from a prosthodontic perspective.
