

# Environmental Services Regulatory Training Guide

This table is intended to assist New York University managers and principal investigators with the identification of environmental health and safety training requirements for personnel in their schools and departments. This table addresses common regulatory training for general job classifications. Specific training is based on a particular staff person's responsibilities. **Red** colored "X," indicates that ES currently offers regularly scheduled training-refer to ES website for training schedules. **Green** color indicates annually required training programs. Employees not in any of these categories should contact ES to determine training needed.
