Central Heating Plant Start-up**

We have just completed a major maintenance upgrade and abatement of the Central Heating Plant (CHP) to improve the plant safety and performance.

At this time, we are now looking to re-energize the central heating plant and begin the process of transferring all buildings back to the NYU high temperature hot water (HTHW) system.

Please note that the Meyer Complex re-heat and domestic hot water systems are scheduled to be transferred back to the NYU CHP on Friday, June 19, 2009 at approximately 10AM. No hot water outage will be necessary during this transfer. The temporary hot water boiler will be shut down but remain connected, until Friday June 26.

The 10# steam will remain fed by the temporary steam boiler. We anticipate transferring the 10# steam load to the NYU CHP the following Friday. (A follow-up notice will be issued to confirm these dates and times).

In order to ensure a smooth transition:

- The temporary boilers will remain connected (but off) for an additional week to provide back-up capability if required during the start-up process.
- Central Plant engineers will be on site during the energizing of the building's hot water systems to immediately respond to any issues.
- Central Plant engineers will be on-call 24/7 to provide service if needed.
