Central Heating Plant Start-up**

We have just completed a major maintenance upgrade and abatement of the Central Heating Plant (CHP) to improve the plant safety, operations, and performance.

At this time, we are now looking to re-energize the central heating plant and begin the process of transferring all buildings back to the NYU high temperature hot water (HTHW) system.

Please note that both Silver Towers and 505 LaGuardia Place are scheduled to be transferred back to the NYU CHP on Monday, June 22, 2009 at approximately 10AM. No hot water outage will be necessary during this transfer. A follow-up notice will be posted to confirm this date and time.

To ensure a smooth transition:

- The temporary boilers will remain connected (but off) for an additional week to provide back-up capability if required during the start-up process.
- Central Plant engineers will be on site during the energizing of the building's hot water systems to immediately respond to any issues.
- Central Plant engineers will be on-call 24/7 to provide service if needed.
