



NYU COGENERATION PROJECT ONE MONTH LOOK-AHEAD

Period: MAY 28 – JUNE 30, 2008

The following is a brief description of upcoming work near the cogeneration site over the next month:

May 27 thru end of June: Con Edison and their sub-contractors will continue working on West 3rd Street, West 4th Street, and Mercer Street to complete the work associated with relocating their electrical vaults from the site. This work entails saw-cutting the streets (most of which has already been completed), excavating a trench in the streets, installing electrical conduits, and then backfilling and repaving the streets.

May 28 thru end of June: Con Edison and their sub-contractors will again return to working on West 4th Street to complete the gas relocation work and then begin removal of the abandoned gas lines located within the site.

May 28 thru end of June: NYU contractor will be continuing with the relocation of sewer, water, gas and electrical utilities located within the site that are presently serving the Warren Weaver building at 251 Mercer Street. No other buildings will be affected by the relocation of these utilities.

May 28 thru June 13: NYU contractor will complete the installation of conduits across Mercer Street just south of 3rd Street into the NYU dorm at 240 Mercer Street.

June 23 thru end of December 2008: Starting the week of June 23rd or shortly thereafter, the excavation contractor will begin the installation of piles in the site. The piles will be drilled the first 15 feet and then driven. This work, although intermittent, is quite disruptive and will last about 5-7 days. The contractor will then begin the excavation of the site.
