What is Interpol?

- Definition

The world's largest international police organization (184 countries).

- Function

It facilitates cross-border police co-operation, and supports and assists all organizations, authorities and services whose mission is to prevent or combat international crime.

- Limits:

Action is taken within the limits of existing laws in different countries and in the spirit of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights. Interpol's constitution prohibits 'any intervention or activities of a **political, military, religious or racial character**.

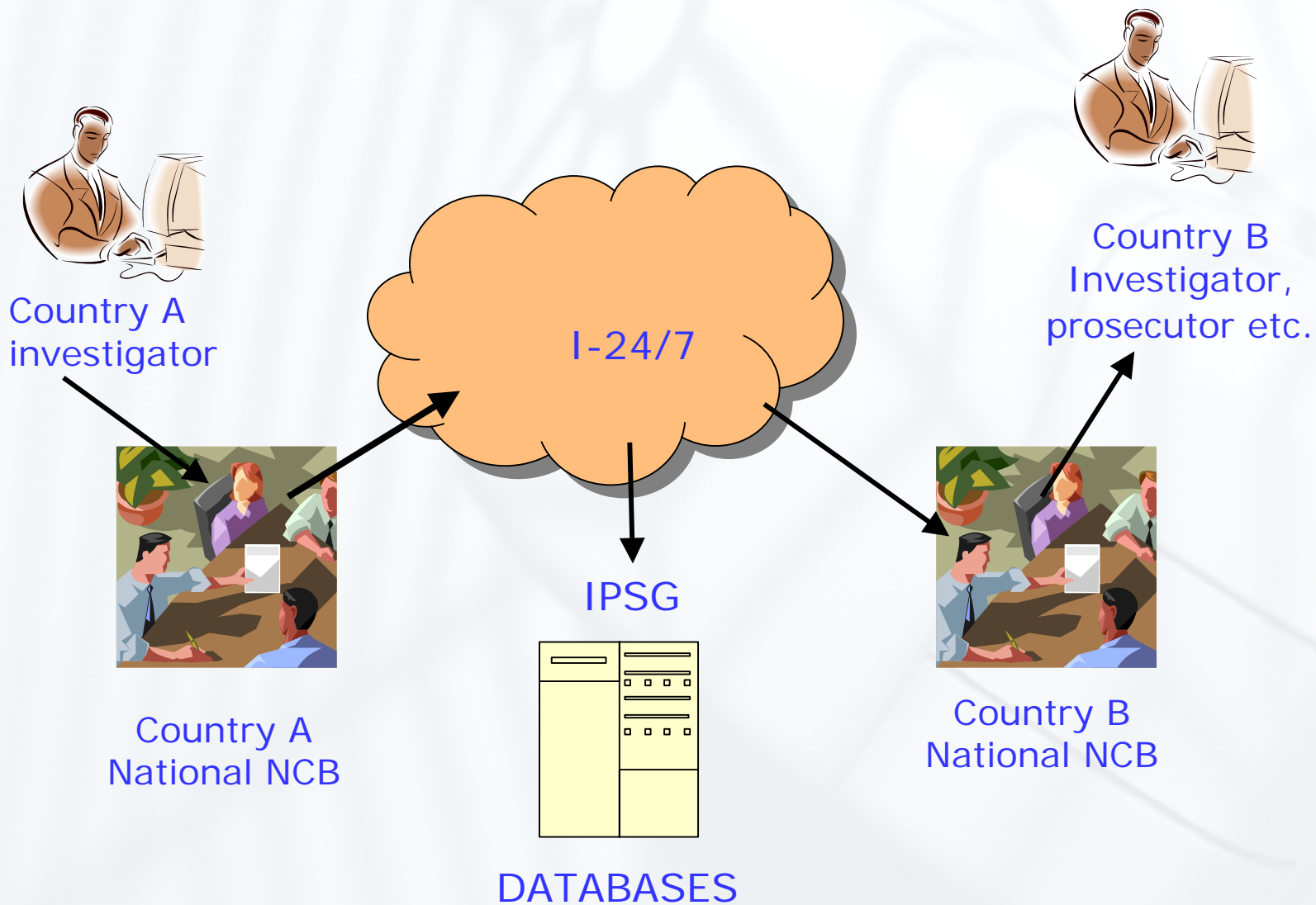

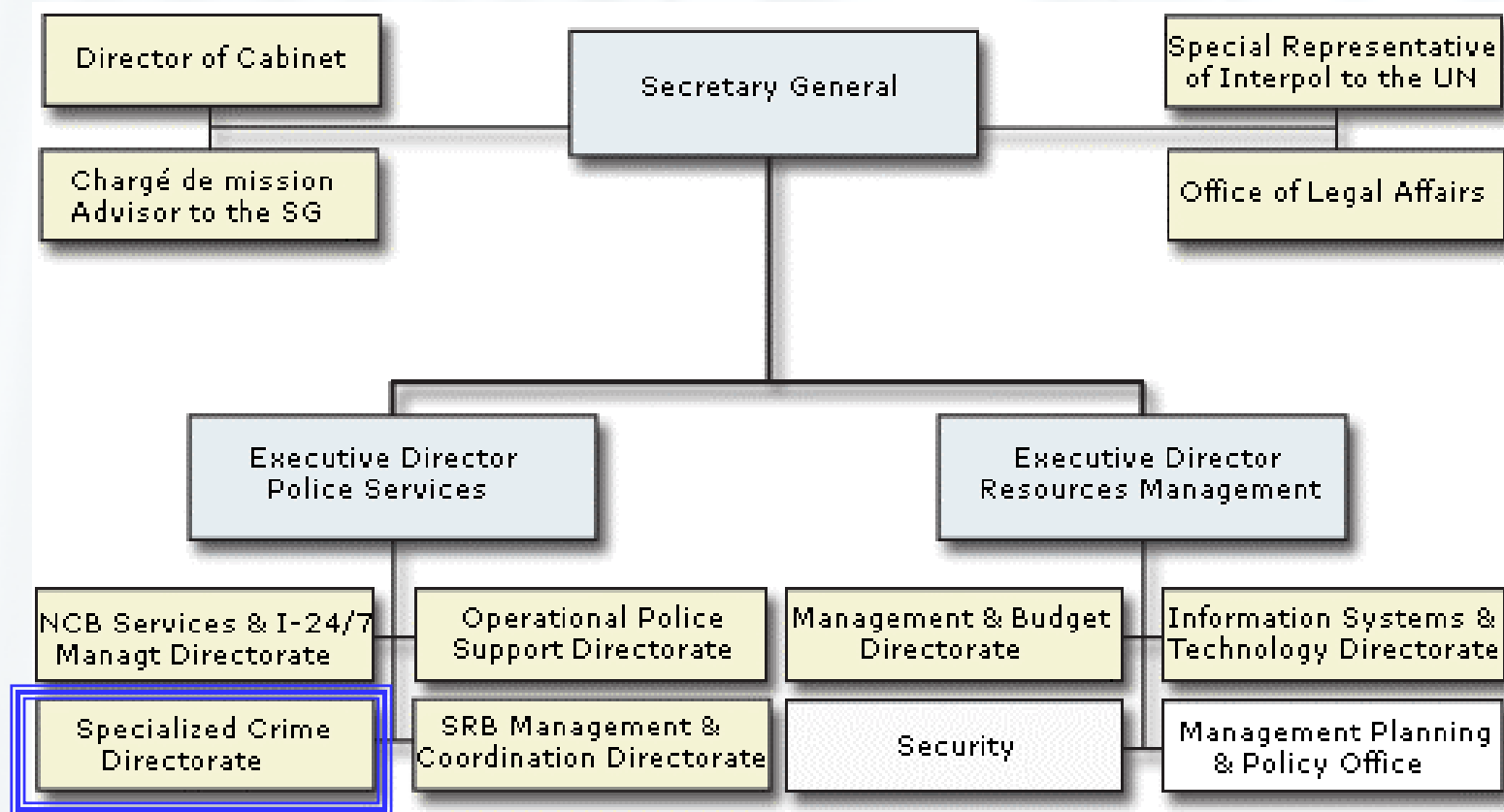
