### University Add/Drop and Refund Schedule ([www.nyu.edu/registrar/calendars/academic-calendar.html#fallTerm](http://www.nyu.edu/registrar/calendars/academic-calendar.html#fallTerm))

**Sept. 8** - Last day to drop and receive 100% refund of both tuition and fees

**Sept. 8 - 14** - Dropping classes after the first official day of classes but within the first week of classes: refund is 100% of tuition only

**Sept. 15** - Late registration begins. Initial registration will be charged a late registration fee of \$25

**Sept. 15 - 21** - Dropping classes within the second calendar week of classes: refund is 70% of tuition only

**Sept. 22 - 28** - Dropping classes within the third calendar week of classes: refund is 55% of tuition only

**Sept. 28** - Last day for drop/add on Albert. Students must contact the program office to drop/add a course

**Sept. 28-** Last Day to Drop Courses and Not Receive a Grade of "W"

**Sept. 20-Oct. 5-** Dropping classes within the fourth calendar week of classes: refund is 25% of tuition only

**Oct. 6** - Withdrawal after completion of the fourth calendar week: No refund
