ADD/DROP/REFUND SCHEDULE

January 19, 2010: Last day to drop and receive 100% refund of both tuition and fees

January 20 - 25, 2010: Dropping classes after the first official day of classes but within the first week of classes: refund is 100% of tuition only

January 26 - February 1, 2010: Dropping classes within the second calendar week of classes: refund is 70% of tuition only

February 2 - February 9, 2010: Dropping classes within the third calendar week of classes: refund is 55% of tuition

February 9 - February 15, 2010: Dropping classes within the fourth calendar week of classes: refund is 25% of tuition only

February 16, 2010 - forward: Dropping classes after completion of the fourth calendar week: No refund.
