Registration

1. All CAS students must consult an adviser to discuss their program and have to have it approved.
2. Prerequisites and corequisites for courses are not always indicated here. They are set forth in the course descriptions of the current online CAS Bulletin. You are responsible for familiarizing yourself with that information before you register.
3. If laboratory and/or recitation sections are listed for a course, you must register for a recitation and/or a laboratory as well as for a lecture.
4. Some courses - such as seminar, honors, tutorial, internship, or independent study courses - are indicated as requiring special permission. They are typically open to majors in the department, or to qualified students in other departments, with permission of the department's director of undergraduate studies and/or the instructor of the course. You should go to the department for the permission, which comes in the form of an "access code."
5. In many Arts & Science departments, certain graduate courses are open to qualified undergraduates with departmental permission. If interested, you should consult the course schedule for the Graduate School of Arts & Science.

Non-CAS Students

Before you consider registering for a class in CAS, consult your school's bulletin or your adviser to review the policy regarding the taking of classes at other divisions. You should then check the online CAS bulletin for course descriptions and prerequisites.
