Registration Information

Liberal Studies Program

Advisement

After consulting with an advisor, all Liberal Studies students are cleared to register by the Liberal Studies Advising Center. Specific registration instructions are sent electronically to the freshman and sophomore class each semester. During the second semester of sophomore year, Liberal Studies sophomores seamlessly transition into the schools to which they originally applied* and will be invited to attend registration information sessions offered by advisors in those schools. (*Some students consider changing direction and apply for admission to a school other than the one to which they originally applied; in such cases the Liberal Studies sophomore must submit an 'Application for Internal Transfer' to the NYU Admissions Office; admission in such cases is not guaranteed and is at the discretion of the Admissions Office.)

LSP Courses

Liberal Studies students may register for any open class listed under the LSP heading. LSP classes do not have waiting lists.

Other NYU Courses

Liberal Studies students may register for non-Liberal studies courses. Liberal Studies sophomores are encouraged to register for courses that meet major or minor requirements in the school to which they intend to transition. Liberal Studies students taking courses outside the program are subject to the rules of the school offering the courses and must meet all prerequisites; if access codes are required, Liberal Studies students must visit the respective departments or programs to acquire them.

Registering

Per instructions sent via e-mail and after consulting with their advisor, all

students will be cleared to register by the Liberal Studies Advising Center. All registration dates are assigned by the NYU Registrar; on the date and at the time assigned (or afterward), the student can register via Albert.

Drop/Add

Students can make changes to their schedules via Albert during the Drop/Add period; as students may add open courses only, students should be careful before dropping a course to make sure that the courses they want to add are open. After the first week of the semester, students are strongly cautioned not to add classes already in progress without consulting with the instructor and the Liberal Studies Advising Center.
