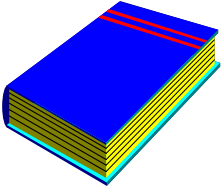

Registration

Each Program in the School of Continuing and Professional Studies has a different registration process. Please contact your program for specific information. All degree students registering for 6 or more points must show proof of immunization to Measles, Mumps and Rubella to the University Health Center, 726 Broadway, 993-1000. Failure to do so may result in being blocked for registration. **Students may not begin a class after the second week of the semester without the program director's permission. Students who register late may be charged a late fee. No student is considered REGISTERED until they have been financially cleared by the Bursar's Office.**

Financial Aid

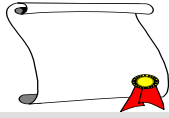
All students applying for Financial Aid must file a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) available on the NYU Office of Financial Aid's website at <http://www.nyu.edu/financial.aid/>. NY state residents may also apply for either the Tuition Assistance Program (TAP) for full time study of 12 or more points or the Aid for Part Time Study (APTS) for students intending to take 11 or less points. Eligibility requirements and deadlines vary; for specific information please check the Office of Financial Aid's website or contact the office at 998-4444 or 25 West 4th Street.

Cross Registration for Non-SCPS Degree Students

1. Before registering for a credit class in SCPS, consult your school's bulletin (and your departmental guidelines where appropriate) to review policies for taking classes in other divisions. Ascertain whether your school and department will give you credit for the proposed course and, if required, obtain written permission from your school. Check the SCPS Bulletins for course descriptions, prerequisites, etc.
2. You will need permission from the SCPS department offering the course.
