Change of Program

An advisor's signature is required at all times. Courses added or dropped without an advisor's signature may be considered as not meeting degree requirements. From the second week, all changes of program must be accompanied by a Course Permission Form and approved in Registration Services. Students are not permitted to register after the third week of the term. International Students

Undergraduate and graduate international students, who need assistance for orientation, preliminary academic assessment, language placement, or clearance regarding English competency, should contact the Office of Student Services, 82 Washington Square East, 2nd Floor, 998-5065.

Non-Matriculating Students

Non-NYU undergraduate and graduate students wishing to register as non-matriculating students must hold clearance letters from the appropriate undergraduate or graduate admissions office before approval by the Special Student Advisor, 82 Washington Square East, Rm. 229, 998-5065.

Certification of Status

Certification for full/half time status must be determined at the time of registration. Full-time Equivalency may affect financial aid. The University defines full-time course work to be a minimum of 12 points per term and part-time course work 6 points per term, which requires a student to spend no less than 40 hours for full-time and 20 hours for part-time on a combination of course work and internships, master's final experience, master's and doctoral thesis research, doctoral qualifying examinations, teaching fellowships, or research and graduate assistantships. Cross School Registration
