

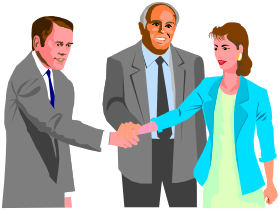

Registration

1. If you are a special (non-matriculated) student, you are permitted to register for a maximum of four graduate courses in the Wagner School. Special and visiting students will be assigned faculty advisors as needed.
2. You should use the courses listed in the Schedule of Classes along with the Wagner Bulletin to check for prerequisites, or consult the Wagner School Web site: <http://wagner.nyu.edu/courses/>
3. Prerequisites may be waived, but only with written permission of the instructor.
4. All Wagner courses are 4 points, except where noted in this schedule.

Cross-School Registration For Non-Wagner Students

1. Before registering for a class in Wagner, consult your school's Bulletin (and your departmental guidelines where appropriate) to review policies for taking classes in other divisions. Then check the Wagner Bulletin or the Web site for course descriptions, prerequisites, times, etc. <http://wagner.nyu.edu/courses/> Finally, ascertain whether your school / department will give credit for the proposed course and whether written permission from your school is required.
2. Superior undergraduates who meet prerequisites, if any, are permitted to register for coursework in the Wagner School, provided that the undergraduate advisor provides written approval.
3. After obtaining your own advisor's signature, you are also required to obtain approval from Wagner's Office of Academic Services. For this approval, see Dr. Charles Nicolson, 295 Lafayette Street 2nd Floor, room 2209, (212) 998-7418. If Dr. Nicolson is not available, you may see the Associate Dean or another administrator.
