Historical Notes: Built as a stable before 1854, probably for a tenant of 4 Washington Square North, which shares its lot. It was later converted for residential use. Acquired by NYU in 1949.

Original & Historic Features

General

- Original appearance of facade is unknown. Existing masonry openings part of an historic alteration.

Note: There is no historic photograph for this building since it shared the same tax lot as 4 WSN.

Non-Historic Alterations

General

- 6/6 and 3/6 wood replacement windows (100%).
- Window openings at 2nd story filled with air-conditioning units.
- Door is an appropriate replacement.
- Entire facade parged and painted. Stucco has raised borders at sides up to 2nd story, and horizontally across 2nd story lintels.
- Flashing covers coping stones.
- Non-historic large lanternlike fixture installed to stucco.
- Non-historic shutters around each window and door.
- Cable wires strung across facade.
