

## MOVING, STORAGE and SHIPPING RESOURCES

### TIPS FOR MOVING OUT

We are often asked whether it is better to store belongings locally over the summer or while studying abroad, or to mail or drive them home. The answer depends on individual circumstances: the distance home, the amount of material to be moved, time, money, and the need for access to belongings during the break. (Don't forget to think about moving back in as well.) That being said, we have a few tips to help you with your decision:

- Think about pooling resources with other students to help save money. It might be cheaper to share a storage space with your future roommate, however, be sure to communicate clearly about expectations in advance, and consider writing down your plans for cost or labor sharing now to avoid confusion later.
- Lightly-used boxes can often be obtained for free or at low cost from local stores or by searching craigslist.org.
- The Residence Halls will often collect unwanted electronics, clothes, home goods, food, and other items to be recycled or donated as part of the move-out period. Check with your building's Resource Center for details.
- Unlike Move-In Day, parking is not reserved on the streets, and there is no one set "move-out" day. Students should check with Residence Hall staff for information regarding procedures for checking-out.
- Many storage facilities offer free move-in, but you have to arrange move-out separately. Also note that some storage facilities may not actually be in Manhattan, but in nearby areas in Brooklyn, Queens or even New Jersey. Be sure to ask if they are near public transportation in the event you need access during the storage period.
- Because of so many choices regarding storage and movers, it never hurts to ask RAs, upper class students, even administrators for suggestions. Moving and storage is a process in NYC and like directions, everyone has an opinion!
