

NYU in Ghana Spring 2010
University of Ghana Application Instructions
Due October 19th

The application is pretty straightforward, but we want to call your attention to a few items before you start filling out the form:

1 Fill out the Application (even if you may not take classes at Legon)

- If you're attending NYU in Ghana, you must fill out the application even if you don't intend to take courses at the University of Ghana, Legon.

2 Use the Sample Application as a Template

- Look over the sample application we've provided on the Ghana Admitted Students page for specifics about how to fill out the form, but note that you'll need to do a little research to fill out question #11.
 - Review the course offerings at the University of Ghana (<http://www.nyu.edu/studyabroad/ghana/course.offerings.legon.html> and <http://www.ug.edu.gh/index1.php?linkid=185&sublinkid=66>), then list a few courses of interest. Don't worry about getting your course choices exactly right! These aren't set in stone. Final registration happens when you arrive in Accra, and you'll be able to choose different courses or decide not to take course at the University of Ghana at all.
- **Note:** Additional course information is available at the University of Ghana website, <http://www.ug.edu.gh/index1.php?linkid=185&sublinkid=66> . With the exception of language and performing arts classes, only 300- or 400-level courses are appropriate for direct enrollment.

3 Return Application with Passport Photos (and two photocopies) by October 19th

- Glue one original passport photo to each copy of the application.
 - No photocopies, personal photos, or scanned photos from home printers will be accepted—the photos must be originals!
 - **Note:** since you're having passport photos taken, you might want to take 4 more for your visa application. Take all of them now to save time and money later!
