Program Objectives for Specialized Study Scholarships

Specialized Study Scholarships are intended to encourage students with focused areas of study to gain an international experience. NYU offers a unique curriculum at each site that meets many requirements for majors or minors that are typically not found in study abroad programs. NYU seeks to assist students from colleges or universities other than NYU who are interested in these subject areas with their study abroad funding needs.

Eligibility

- Must be a full-time degree seeking student from an accredited US higher education institution that does not have an institutional relationship with NYU. Please check with your school's Study Abroad/International Education office if you are not sure if your school has a relationship with NYU.
- Must have applied to or received an admission offer from NYU Study Abroad.
- Must agree to enroll in at least two specialized courses while studying abroad. Previous coursework or academic interest in the specified subject area is preferred but not required.

Specialized Study Scholarships

Awards are available in the subject areas below. Recipients must enroll in at least two courses in the specified subject area while studying abroad. Students spending a fall semester abroad who are interested in extending their time abroad to a full year may request to renew their awards for the following spring semester. Recipients interested in renewing their awards must continue to meet all eligibility criteria and notify NYU Global Programs by completing an "Extended Stay Application" form before November 1st.

Requirements and Criteria

Specialized Study Scholarships are merit-based awards and applicants are evaluated on academic strength, motivation and intent. Financial need is not taken into account. Students with financial need may submit a separate application for need-based aid (see Web site for details). Applicants are not required to have completed previous coursework in the scholarship subject area; however, priority will be given to students who will receive credit towards their major or minor for specialized coursework completed while studying abroad through NYU.

Application Materials

Applicants should submit the following materials. The official transcript submitted with your NYU Study Abroad application will be used to evaluate academic strength.

1. A completed and signed application form.
2. A one page essay on the subject "Why NYU study abroad is the right fit for my course of study".
3. (Optional but not required) any additional documentation – essays, writings, recordings or artwork – that expresses why you are the right applicant to receive the specialized study scholarship.
