



Benjamin A. Gilman International Scholarship

Enclosed is information regarding the Benjamin A. Gilman International Scholarship, a congressionally funded program sponsored by the Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs of the U.S. Department of State and administered by the Institute of International Education. We encourage you to apply and are happy to discuss the application process with if needed.

1. Visit www.iie.org/gilman to learn more about the Gilman scholarship and if you are eligible to apply. The online application is also available at this site. Please note that only students **currently receiving federal Pell Grant funding during the academic term of their application** are eligible to apply.

2. Contact your academic advisor or the Office of Global Programs if you have questions or need assistance with the application.

3. Complete the Gilman Authorization to Release Financial Information (page 2 of this document) and submit it to the Office of Global Programs **no later than April 1st for fall semester and October 1st for spring semester**.

4. Please note that the application requires that you send 3 copies of your official transcript, which must be postmarked. You must request these transcripts from the registrar's office yourself. Transcripts postmarked after the deadline will not be accepted and your application will be considered incomplete. The address to which to send your transcripts will be provided to you after you submit the on-line student portion of your application. As it can take approximately **five business days** for requested transcripts to be mailed, be sure to request your transcripts from the Registrar in plenty of time.

5. Complete the online application (use the contact information below on the application) by the due date.
