- A personal statement of 250 to 500 words addressing your motivation for wanting to enroll in your selected Arts and Science study abroad program. How will the program you have chosen benefit you (academically, personally, etc.)? If you select a second-choice program, please include a personal statement for that program as well.
- A \$25 application processing fee (non-NYU applicants only)—check or money order only, made payable to New York University.
- Official transcript (non-NYU applicants only).
- If you have chosen language courses above the elementary level, you must submit evidence of your proficiency. If this is not apparent from your academic transcript, you are required to submit a letter from a language instructor, recent placement test scores, or an AP score of 4 or 5.

Incomplete applications will not be processed. Admission decisions are based on strength of academic performance, personal statement, any necessary supplemental materials, and whether there is space remaining in the program. Programs may fill without notice. If a program is already filled, you may be placed on a waiting list or asked to select a different program.
