## Excursions

Excursions are designed to enrich the course curriculum. The program organizes visits to sites within Florence as well as day trips on most Fridays. Destinations typically included in the program are western Tuscany and weekend trips to Rome and the Amalfi Coast (to include Pompeii).

## Housing

Students reside in Villa Natalia at La Pietra, NYU's academic center in Florence. Facilities are air-conditioned and include a cafeteria, computer lab, Wi-Fi, student lounge, laundry facilities, and a small gym. The greater La Pietra facilities include multimedia-equipped classrooms, a screening room, two computer labs, a reference library, and a second cafeteria with terrace.
