NYU 2009 summer housing license

1. LICENSE This License is for dormitory use of an assigned space in a room or suite (the "room") in any NYU summer housing facility, including any facility that NYU may now or hereafter own, lease, or otherwise arrange to make available for summer housing. NYU shall select and may change at any time, in its sole discretion, the space to which you will be assigned and the furnishings, features, and other occupants of the room. If you request a residence hall or type of accommodation that is not available, you will be assigned to and charged the rate for alternative accommodations chosen by NYU. Roommate requests based upon race, color, religion, sexual orientation, physical characteristics, or national origin cannot be accepted.

2. LICENSE PERIOD Summer housing is available and licenses are issued only for continuous calendar weeks, Sunday to Saturday, commencing at 9 am any Sunday between May 17 and July 19, 2009, and ending at 12 Noon any Saturday between June 6 and August 8, 2009. The minimum stay is three (3) consecutive weeks. This License expires at the end of your License Period, unless it is canceled or terminated earlier as specified below. Your License Period cannot be shortened or extended without Housing's prior written approval. You waive any right that you may have or acquire to remain in the assigned space beyond the end of the License Period.

3. ELIGIBILITY (A) You must remain throughout the License Period an NYU student, or a participant in another program at NYU, who meets the eligibility requirements set by the NYU Department of Housing, Office of Summer Housing ("Housing"). (B) You must be at least 17 years of age.

4. CANCELLATION OF LICENSE (A) This License binds you for the entire License Period unless Housing receives your written request to cancel this License or to shorten the License Period. Cancellations of all or part of the License Period are subject to a cancellation fee. The cancellation fee is in accordance with the written fee schedule and is determined by the date the Office of Summer Housing receives written notification of your cancellation. (B) If you do not check in by the Thursday after your License Period begins and have not given prior written notice of your late arrival to Housing, your housing reservation and License will be canceled with cancellation charges. (C) If you vacate the room prior to the end of the License Period without submitting a cancellation request to Housing and checking out and returning your keys at your residence hall desk, you will not receive a refund.

5. TERMINATION OF LICENSE NYU reserves the right at any time, in its sole discretion, to terminate this License, to suspend you from student housing, to postpone or cancel the assignment of any space, or to postpone the commencement of the License Period (A) if you fail to pay any sum due under this License when due, violate any other term of this License, cease to be eligible for summer housing, or fail to occupy or improperly vacate the assigned space; (B) if the assigned space is unavailable for dormitory use or unusable due to any damage, construction, renovation, or repair; or (C) for any other reason that NYU, in its sole discretion, deems to be good cause. If this License is terminated because of your failure fully to perform any of your obligations under this License, you will continue to be responsible for all fees due under or as a consequence of this License for the entire original License Period.

6. FEES AND PAYMENTS (A) Your eligibility for specific room rates depends on your NYU summer course enrollment, as defined in the 2008 Summer Housing Guidebook. If your enrollment status changes, your housing charges will be recalculated retroactively at the applicable rate and you will be billed or credited accordingly. (B) You must submit payment for all charges due for your entire License Period with your housing application unless you want to defer part of your payment. In such case, you must submit payment for all charges due for your required minimum stay (3 weeks) with your application; all deferred charges must be paid by the last business day of the first week of the License. (C) All other charges due under or as a consequence of this License (including, without being limited to, all applicable meal plan charges) must be received by the due dates specified in the bills and statements that you will receive from NYU, or NYU may terminate this License, withhold registration and academic records, and hold you responsible for all costs, including collection agency and legal fees, incurred by NYU in collecting past-due payments owed under this License.

7. OCCUPANCY AND USE (A) You alone must occupy your assigned space during the License Period. (B) Any vacant space in the room may be filled by Housing without prior notice to you. You shall not interfere with any new occupant's use or enjoyment of the space or room. (C) You may not transfer or assign any rights you may have under this License to any other person; any attempt to do so shall be null and void. (D) You shall use the room only for dormitory purposes and shall not permit any other person to use the room for any purpose without Housing's prior written approval.

8. REGULATIONS You agree to review and abide by all policies and regulations of NYU and Housing that are or shall become effective during the License Period. These policies and regulations are included in the 2009 Summer Housing Guidebook, NYU Student's Guide, Residential Education Handbook, and other publications distributed by and available at Housing. If you violate any such policy or regulation, you will be subject to disciplinary action and/or termination of this License without refund by NYU, in its sole discretion. All meal plans are subject to Dining Services policies, procedures, and service schedules; violators will be subject to disciplinary action and/or termination of their meal plan without refund.

9. MEAL PLANS (A) If you are assigned to Brittany, Goddard, Hayden, Rubin, or Weinstein Hall, you are required to maintain a meal plan during the License Period. (B) Meal plans are not transferable to any other person. (C) Meal plans cannot be canceled, whether used or not, unless this License is canceled or terminated by NYU or unless you make a written request (apartment-style residents only) at Summer Housing. Meal plan cancellation/changes are not retroactive.

10. ACCESS NYU reserves the right, at any time and for any reason, in its sole discretion, to enter the room without prior notice to you to make repairs; to inspect for compliance with health, fire, or building codes or with NYU policies or regulations; or because of any situation that NYU, in its sole discretion, deems to be a danger to health, safety, or property.

11. CONDITION OF PREMISES (A) You shall maintain the room in a clean, safe, and undamaged condition at all times. You and any other persons assigned to the room shall be jointly responsible for cleaning and maintaining any kitchens, bathrooms, or other common areas. (B) You shall not alter the room or any furnishings therein in any way without Housing's prior written consent. (C) When you vacate your assigned space, you shall remove all your personal property and leave the room and any furnishings clean and in the same condition they were in when you commenced occupancy, ordinary wear and tear excepted. You agree that NYU may promptly dispose of any personal property left in the room after the end of the License Period. NYU will assess cleaning, repair, and disposal charges equally among all those assigned to the room, unless individual responsibility is established before departure. (D) Charges for damage to any public area or furnishings in a housing facility may be assessed, in NYU's sole discretion, against any or all of those assigned to the floor or the entire facility.

12. PERSONAL PROPERTY NYU shall not be liable or otherwise responsible in any way for any loss of or damage to your personal property, whatever the cause of such loss or damage.

13. VACATE PROCEDURES You shall vacate your assigned space, and officially check out and return all keys, by the end of the License Period (immediately upon cancellation or termination of this License). If you do not officially check out, return your keys, and vacate the space by that date, NYU reserves the right to change the locks for the room and not to allow you to enter the room or the facility in which it is located. You shall also be responsible for all costs and direct or indirect damages suffered by NYU in connection with your failure to check out and vacate by that date, including, without being limited to, the cost of accommodations for each person who would otherwise have occupied the assigned space and all legal and other expenses incurred by NYU in connection with removing you from the space.

14. MISCELLANEOUS (A) This License is the sole agreement between you and NYU regarding the assigned space and may not be changed except by an instrument in writing signed by Housing and you. (B) If any provision of this License shall be found to be invalid, the remaining provisions hereof shall continue in full force and effect. (C) In the event of a court determination of any NYU liability to you in connection with this License, the aggregate amount of damages to be paid by NYU shall not exceed the sum you paid under this License. (D) This License shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of New York applicable to contracts made and to be performed therein. You agree to submit to the jurisdiction of the federal and state courts in New York County, New York State, for the resolution of any disputes arising hereunder. (E) Time shall be of the essence in the performance of each of your obligations under this License.
