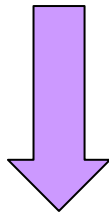

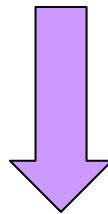
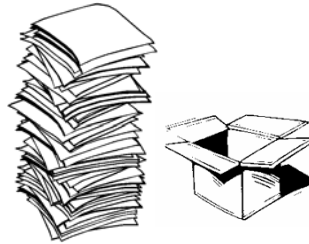
For a better tomorrow

bin on your floor!



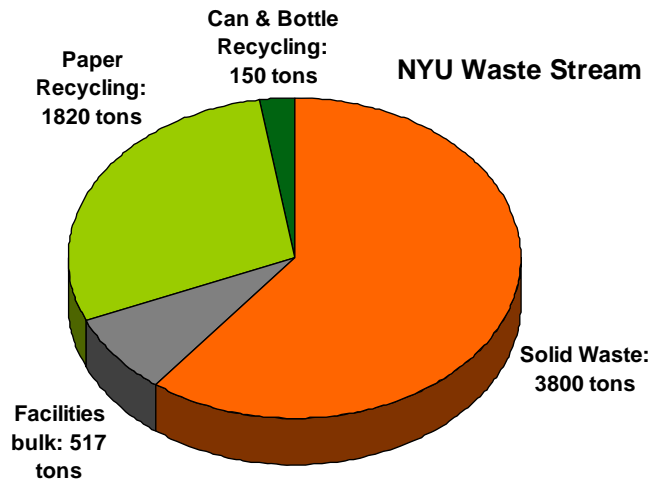

NYU Recycles

In honor of America Recycles Day, November 15, we'd like to remind everyone to do their part and recycle!

THE FACTS:

- Waste is a byproduct of every aspect of daily life at NYU.
- Administrative offices, computer labs, dining halls and dorms are major sources of waste.
- NYU recycles ~1/3 of its waste stream and is striving to increase that rate.



WHAT CAN WE RECYCLE?

•Mixed Paper

- Yes: white and colored paper, printer paper, junk mail, newspapers, magazines, cardboard, etc.
- No: tissues or paper contaminated with food waste

•Cans and Bottles

- Yes: Aluminum/Steel cans, glass and plastic bottles, and milk jugs (types “1” and “2” plastic)
- No: window glass, broken mirrors, ceramics, plastic bags, wrappers

•**Toner & Printer Cartridges** Drop them off at any of these locations: NYU Mail services, Third Ave IT Department, or the Recycling Shop at 7 E 12th St (Fairchild Building)

•**Techno Scrap** CDs, floppy disks, cell phones, pagers, etc.

•Batteries

- Yes: Rechargeable batteries including cell phone, laptop and cordless phone batteries
- No: Disposable “Standard” Alkaline batteries

•Electronics, appliances, fluorescent tubes and ballasts, oil paint, solvents, rags: Call Building Manager for collection.

WHAT CAN WE REUSE?

- Clothing, linens, books, food, moving boxes*
- Furniture: Call Asset Management for collection
