JOB: *Student* position for student producer/editor/camera operator

HOURS: Part-time student employment (10-20 hours per week, flexible hours); two term commitment required (at least one full academic year).

SALARY: Based on Experience; Work Study Preferred.

DESCRIPTION: The primary responsibility is to create video programs for the NYU-TV Network. Students will be given guidelines for shooting and editing educational videos, including full-length programs and segments of lectures, university events, performances, promos, and more. In addition, students may be asked to produce (e.g. write, shoot, edit) short segments for air on NYU-TV (promos, giveaways, "The Square"). The student producer will also provide production assistance for field and studio productions.

SKILL REQUIREMENTS: Strong background in video production required.

Editing software: Proficiency with Final Cut Studio, Mac OSX. Experience with Adobe Creative Suite (Photoshop, Flash, After Effects, Dreamweaver), DVD authoring, and transcoding workflows also recommended.

Producing Skills: Ability to craft a story/segment that informs and entertains through written, oral, and visual media.

Video/Camera: Hands-on experience with digital video cameras and recording (Panasonic P2 workflow knowledge a plus).

Production Assistance: Provide production assistance, which includes moving and lifting up to 20 - 40lbs of equipment, errands/deliveries, craft services, and general office assignments, as needed.

Transferable skills: Must have good communication skills, including strong organization and time management skills. Be a self-starter, have strong attention to detail, and be able to work in a fast paced environment, under deadline.
