The NYU Brightspace LMS Steering Committee has formally concluded its work with the full implementation of Brightspace across the University (to be completed by the start of the 'J-term.')

The focus of the initiative, moving forward, will now be on operations and support.

As such, the TEE Committee will focus its attention on the following initiatives starting the Spring Semester '22:

Developing a committee statement on real-time class recordings; a position guideline

Resumption of the work on the 'digital natives' report (this working title for the project will be rebranded as soon as possible)

Developing a proposed list of issues on 'high-stakes testing and proctoring.'
