Resolution regarding Faculty Senate Representation from the School of Continuing and Professional Studies (SCPS)

Approved 9/13/12

At the September 13, 2012 meeting of the Faculty Senators Council, the Council approved the following resolution:

Background:

In keeping with the practice that each School be represented by at least one Senator, and in view of the fact that the only eligible faculty member did not respond to an invitation sent April 26, 2012 to serve as a Senator, the Faculty Senators Council (FSC) passed the resolution below at its first meeting of the year. The FSC also asked the Executive Committee to determine whether a retired faculty member would be eligible to serve as a voting member of FSC.

IT IS RESOLVED: That the Faculty Senators Council extend an invitation to the most recent School of Continuing and Professional Studies (SCPS) senator, Carl Lebowitz, to serve on the Council for a one year term.
