<input type="checkbox"/> Does he/she encourage visits to the school?	
<b>The Environment</b>	
<b><i>Questions to Ask</i></b>	
<input type="checkbox"/> What outdoor space(s) are used? (Public park? Private playground?)

<input type="checkbox"/> What happens in the event of bad weather?	
<input type="checkbox"/> Do children go on community field trips?	
<input type="checkbox"/> Are there any animals in the classrooms?	
<b><i>Things to Observe</i></b>	
<input type="checkbox"/> Is there enough room for children to play safely?	
<input type="checkbox"/> Are the decorations cheerful and bright without feeling overwhelming?	
<input type="checkbox"/> Is children's original work displayed? Is it at children's eye level?

<input type="checkbox"/> Can children reach toys without help?	
<input type="checkbox"/> Does everything look clean and well cared for?

<i>Questions to Ask</i>	
<input type="checkbox"/> What education/experience do the teachers have regarding young children?	
<input type="checkbox"/> Is the staff trained in CPR/first aid?	
<input type="checkbox"/> How long have the teachers and staff members worked with the program? In early childhood?	
<input type="checkbox"/> How does the program select new teachers?	
<i>Things to Observe</i>	
<input type="checkbox"/> Does the ratio of children to adults meet Department of Health codes?	
<input type="checkbox"/> Do teachers speak to children warmly and with respect?	
<input type="checkbox"/> Do they seem to know the children and the program's routines well?	
<input type="checkbox"/> Do they get down on the floor and interact with children at their level?	
<input type="checkbox"/> Do teachers interact with adults (parents and one another) in a positive manner?	
<b>Policies and Practices</b>	
<i>Questions to Ask</i>	
<input type="checkbox"/> Are there sign-in/out procedures?	
<input type="checkbox"/> Is there an open door policy? Can parents visit at any time?	
<input type="checkbox"/> How does the center address parent-child separation?	
<input type="checkbox"/> What is the daily schedule? Do all classes follow a set curriculum? What is the curriculum?	
<input type="checkbox"/> What happens when a child is sick or injured?	
<input type="checkbox"/> What happens when a child misbehaves? Are there clear discipline procedures?	
<input type="checkbox"/> Are there established routines for eating, changing diapers, napping and cleaning up?	
<input type="checkbox"/> Are snacks, meals, and/or diapers provided?	
<input type="checkbox"/> Is there a contract that outlines fees?	

<input type="checkbox"/> Is financial assistance available? Sibling discount?	
<b><i>Things to Observe</i></b>	
<input type="checkbox"/> Is the schedule posted in a kid-friendly way? Do children seem to know the routines?	
<input type="checkbox"/> Are policies posted? (i.e. parent bulletin board, website, leaflets)	
<input type="checkbox"/> Do you see teachers and children following procedures and routines?	
<b>Health and Safety</b>	
<b><i>Questions to Ask</i></b>	
<input type="checkbox"/> Are children supervised at all times? Even when napping?	
<input type="checkbox"/> Are practice fire drills performed on a regular basis?	
<input type="checkbox"/> Are you authorized to dispense medication?	
<b><i>Things to Observe</i></b>	
<input type="checkbox"/> Are outlets covered? Are windows, doors, cabinets and stairs appropriately secured?	
<input type="checkbox"/> Are there signs posted about hand washing procedures?	
<input type="checkbox"/> Do you see children washing their hands before eating or after playing outside?	
<input type="checkbox"/> Are emergency procedures posted?	
<b>Communication</b>	
<b><i>Questions to Ask</i></b>	
<input type="checkbox"/> How do teachers maintain contact with parents? (conversation, written communication, conferences)	
<input type="checkbox"/> Are teachers willing to accommodate requests for meetings or phone calls?	
<input type="checkbox"/> Does the program require that parents dedicate time or service?	
<input type="checkbox"/> Are there occasions or events where parents can interact with one another?	
<input type="checkbox"/> Are the teachers willing to give you the contact information of several parents to speak to as references?
