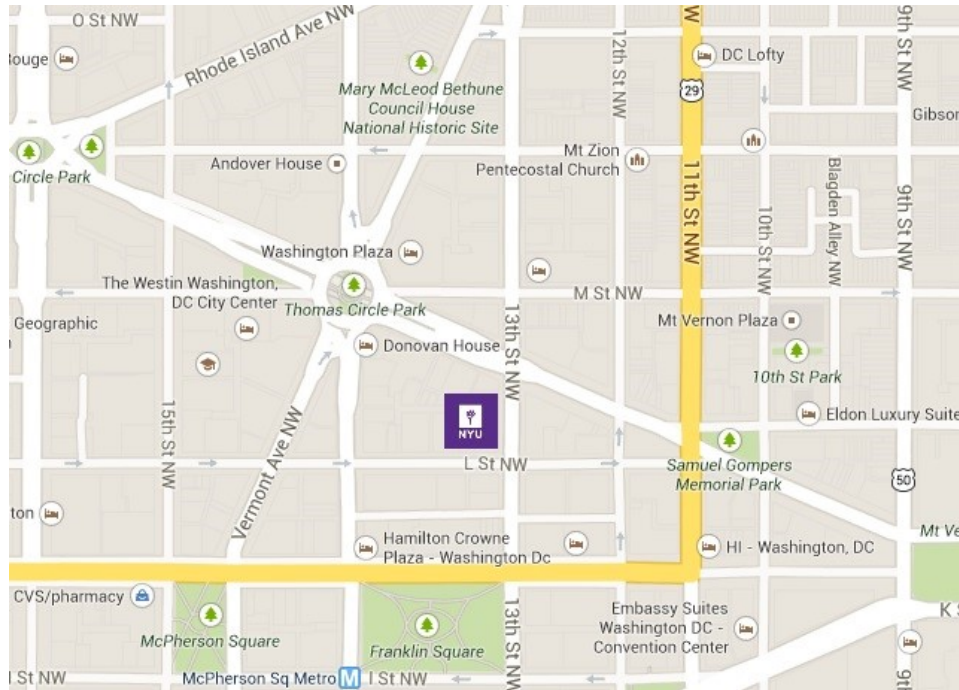

### **Directions via Metro**

#### **Red and Blue/Orange Line from Metro Center**

1. Exit the station via the 12th Street exit.
2. Walk north on 12th Street so the letter streets get higher (H, I, K, L).
3. Turn left on L Street.
4. The building is on the right side of the street, immediately after 13th Street.

#### **Red Line from Farragut North**

1. Exit the station via the L Street exit.
2. Walk away from Connecticut Avenue down L Street.
3. The building is on the left side of the street.

#### **Blue/Orange Line from McPherson Square**

1. Exit the station via the 14th and I Street exit.
2. Walk north on 14th Street so the letter streets get higher (H, I, K, L).
3. Turn right on L Street.
4. NYU Washington, DC is on the left side of the street, closer to 13th Street.

## **Directions by Car\***

*Note\*: L Street is one-way, going eastward.*

### **From the South**

1. Take 95 North to 395 North.
2. Follow 395 North to the 12th Street exit.
3. Exit on 12th Street, N.W., and proceed to K Street.
4. Turn left on K Street and proceed to 14th Street. Turn right on 14th Street, and right again on L Street.
5. The building is on the left side of the street closer to 13th Street.

### **From the North**

1. Take the Baltimore-Washington Parkway (295 South).
2. Stay on the parkway 20-25 miles.
3. Take the New York Avenue exit (50 West) into Washington.
4. You will be entering Washington on the northeast side.
5. Continue onto New York Avenue NW. Continue onto Mt. Vernon Place NW, and again onto Massachusetts Avenue NW.
6. Make a slight right onto Thomas Circle NW.
7. At the traffic circle, exit onto 14th Street NW.
8. Turn left onto L Street NW.
9. The building is on the left side of the street closer to 13th Street.

### **From the East**

1. Take I-66 E and continue onto US-50E/Constitution Ave NW.
2. Turn left onto 15th Street NW.
3. Continue onto Vermont Avenue NW.
4. Turn right onto L Street NW.
5. The building is on the left side of the street closer to 13th Street.

### **From the West**

1. Take 66 or 267 toll road East toward Washington.
2. Cross the Potomac River and merge onto Constitution Ave.
3. Take a left on 15th Street NW and continue onto Vermont Avenue NW.
4. Turn right onto L Street NW.
5. The building is on the left side of the street closer to 13th Street.
