We would like to move forward to set up an inaugural meeting which will include lawyers who will provide an overview of the purview of the OSOO as outlined in the Restrictive Declaration, filed in concert with the NYU Core plan. They will also provide an overview of the rules and obligations that attend board service on a 501(c)(3). As you may be aware, the University will provide some technical assistance to this free-standing entity, but it is not a University-run entity.
